

The Supplementary Protocol entered into force on 5 March 2018!

The Nagoya – Kuala Lumpur Supplementary Protocol on Liability and Redress to the Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety was adopted as supplementary agreement to the Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety, with aim to contribute to the conservation and sustainable use of biodiversity by providing international rules and procedures in the field of **liability and redress relating to living modified organisms**. The Supplementary Protocol was adopted and open for accession after long and difficult international deliberations in 2010, and entered into force on 5 March 2018 after its ratification by 40 Parties to the Cartagena Protocol. The Czech Republic ratified the Supplementary Protocol in 2012.

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
